Nowhere is the influence of music on how we perceive a film's narrative more obvious than with the film programme of the EUROPEAN TALENT AWARD. This year it has been the short film „Apollo“ by Felix Gönnert which, as part of the competition, has been given a new soundtrack.

The winner of the FILM SCORE category will be given the opportunity to record a composition with the WDR Rundfunkorchester Köln. For the prize in the SOUND DESIGN category Studio Funk Produktionshaus für Audiovisuelles will let the winner use their Hamburg studios for a cinema editing session.
